Call us at 989.793.0000, or text us at 989.262.0032. We will provide you with facts, no pressure, and without judgment. We want to answer all your questions so that you can decide if making an adoption plan is right for you.

Create an Adoption Plan

Your adoption specialist will help you create a plan based on your wishes and what you envision for your child. You can choose the adoptive family, determine how much contact you will have after the adoption, and make your hospital plan for when the baby is born. All of these choices are yours to make.

Choose a Family

We can show you profiles of families who may be a good match for you. The choice is 100% yours to make. Once you select a family, we will arrange for you to get to know them if you wish. You are in control of what the relationship looks like.

Plan Your Baby's Birth

Your adoption specialist will help you plan your hospital stay and talk about your personal requests during your time in the hospital. We will be available for you when you give birth and will handle everything adoption-related at the hospital

Placement & Post Pregnancy Support

We will take care of the legal process and assist you through it. After the baby is born, we are still here to offer support and we are happy to remain connected with you after your adoption plan is complete, for as long as you'd like. Professional counseling is available if you choose.



OPENNESS IN ADOPTION

From traditional or closed, to fully open and more modern, we can help you determine what's right for you and your baby.

Open

A fully open adoption means there is an exchange of identifying information between you and the adoptive parents. As your child grows, you and the adoptive family are in direct contact with each other and may have visits together.

Semi-open

You can choose a semi-open adoption, where you and the adoptive parents meet each other before placement, exchange non-identifying information, and then make a plan for limited ongoing contact after the adoption. This means you'll receive regular updates and pictures that can be passed back and forth through the agency.

Closed

While closed adoptions are considered by many to be a thing of the past, some women believe their circumstances are such that ongoing contact would not be ideal for them or their child. We respect your right to choose and will never pressure you into an open relationship.





Why should I work with an agency?

We will provide you with all the information you need to make the best decision for you and your child. We will help you choose the right family that matches your specific needs and take care of the legal work. No pressure, no judgment.

Is there a cost?

There are no costs to birth parents through the agency.

What about my baby's father?

Your baby's father may be involved and can be part of the adoption planning, or he might be completely out of the picture by the time your baby is born. Whatever the situation, it's important to understand his rights and responsibilities. We will help you each step of the way and treat the information you share with us confidentially.

What if I'm homeless or need financial help?

We can help you secure housing through community resources. We can also help with living and medical expenses. We will do all we can to assure that your needs are met based on your specific situation.

How can I be sure my child is going to a loving and stable home?

All adoptive families approved by Adoption Partners go through a lengthy interview process, have excellent references, employment verification, health and medical screening, and are approved and cleared by the State Police and Protective Services. You have the right to review the family's approved home study to learn more about them.
